Dear Friends,

It seems in this time of year that it is a great time for us to be reading the Wisdom books of the Bible - Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, and Song of Songs.

If you go into a Christian – or even a non-Christian – gift store in this graduation season, you will see tons of gifts with verses from Proverbs. This book was written as an instruction book from Solomon to share his wisdom with his son, so that the next generation could rule with the wisdom that had made Solomon's rule so successful.

So during this graduation season, I would like to share a few of these verses that can inspire and instruct a graduate, or anyone who is looking to incorporate more wisdom in their life.

- "Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will succeed." Proverbs 16:3 Continue on in your path with faith as a big part of it. It'll help you reach your goal.
- "Know God in all your paths, and he will keep your ways straight." Proverbs 3:6 As long as we keep God's word at the forefront of our thoughts and actions, God will guide us on our paths.
- "The plans of the diligent end up in profit but those who hurry end up with loss." Proverbs 21:5 It's easy to compare ourselves to others who are soaring ahead on their own paths, but remember that it's OK if it takes more time to get established after graduation. If you work hard and diligently, you will be rewarded in the long run.
- "Know that wisdom is like that for your whole being. If you find it, there is a future. Your hope won't be cut off." Proverbs 24:24 The knowledge you gained in school will help you in your future whether through practical application or even just the lessons you learned outside the classroom about being social, working hard, and managing deadlines. Soak it all in and use it to your advantage going forward.
- "Walk with wise people and become wise; befriend fools and get in trouble." Proverbs 13:20 The people you knew in school who were smart, hard workers will make the best connections as you move on in life. Don't hang around with people who drag you or your goals down.
- "Listen to advice and accept instruction, so you might grow wise in the future. Many plans are in the person's mind, but the Lord's purpose will succeed." Proverbs 19:20-21 Even when you think you have it all figured out, listen to those around you as well. And know that even if you think you have a set plan, the Lord's plan is what will prevail above all. Don't be discouraged if things don't go the way you thought.
- "Strength and honor are her clothing; she is confident about the future." Proverbs 31:25 Even if you're unsure about the next steps in your life, head into them with confidence. God has given you the strength to forge ahead.

I send all the best to all of the graduates. Whatever the next stage is for you, may you go boldly forward, knowing that you can do all things through Christ who strengthens you. Between the wisdom of God and the strength of Christ, there is nothing to fear and everything to gain.

Mom's Morning Out is now accepting applications for 2023-2024 school year

Mom's Morning Out is a preschool for three and four year old children, providing an excellent foundation in educational/social experiences for their first and even second year. Our program provides opportunities to learn about letters, numbers, concepts such as; over, under, on, etc., colors, shapes, to transition from one activity to another, follow directions, use manners, enhance listening skills, become a classroom helper, speak in front of a group, participate in creative/fine/gross motor activities. Students also learn to increase socialization, to correctly solve disputes with other children, to take turns, play cooperatively and to become more independent. We will be beginning our 45th year this fall. Younger students must be 3 years of age on or before August 31st, 2023 and be fully toilet trained.

Mom's Morning Out closely follows the Fonda-Fultonville Central School calendar with some exceptions. Our first day of school will be Friday, September 8th, 2022 and will end on Friday, June 14, 2023. We meet on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8:30 to 11:00 a.m.

Enrollment is filled on a first-come first-serve basis, with priority given to students who attended the previous year. For any questions about the program or to receive an application, please call Joann Phelps (518) 775-3454.
