Dear Friends,

As I began to think about the Easter season - which begins on Easter Sunday and goes through Pentecost, I decided that the theme for the season would be "Surprise!" As I prepared for the sermons, I thought that what would be great was a bulletin cover with a gift box opening, spraying confetti and saying "Surprise!"

Not being able to find what I wanted in any of the clip art libraries I use, I did what people do now - I turned to AI. Using an art program, I put in a description of what I wanted and waited while the computer created something. And after a few tries, it was great — an open box spraying confetti. I quickly sent the art to both church admins to put on the bulletin cover on April 27th. I looked at it. They both looked at it. We all checked it multiple times as the bulletin process played out. (I think you can see where this is going...)

On the morning of the 27th, I looked a the buletin and realized…it didn't say surprise. The beautiful gift box spraying confetti said, "SURPPISE!" And the r didn't even look like an r. Huge fail for Al and for me.

So I did the good Christian thing, and I confessed. I explained at announcement time and I emphasized to all the students in attendance that this is why you do not trust AI with anything important.

We all had a good laugh and that was that.

But as I thought a bit more about it later, I wondered if this might not be a lesson for the church. God has given us all the information and training to create a perfect church. We have the word of God, and the words of Jesus. We have the Spirit leading us in right paths and placing faith in our hearts. God has created a very good creation for us to live and work in. All is in place for us to be the people that we are called to be. And yet...we aren't.

We use all of these things. We – on our best days – are better than most. But on our worst days, we can be just as bad as the world we are called to improve. And sometimes the world looks at us in our imperfection and wonders how we can even claim to speak for God. The world sees the extra p and the character that sort of looks like an r and writes us off as a huge fail

But God never writes us off. God knows that the church of Christ was perfect when imagined by Christ, but was placed in imperfect, human hands. God celebrates when we get it right – when we reflect God's love and light into the world. When we share the love of Christ and serve the least of these. And when we get it wrong, God nudges us back on track and listens when we confess and repent. God calls us to not be afraid to learn from our mistakes and to make corrections. We will never be perfect, for we are human, but we hope to get better and better, and closer and closer to being the church that is as God would have it be.
