#### Dear friends,

This June, I was honored to serve as a delegate to the Reformed Church in America's General Synod. Delegates from all over the world – the usual United States and Canada, but also Central and South America – met in Tucson, Arizona to hear and reflect on the current ministry of the RCA and also to make decisions as to where we want to be in the future.

A few Frequently Asked Questions up front - Yes, it was super hot (The Wednesday we were there it hit 105). Yes, I had travel issues — although not as bad as the group that spent a day and a half in Houston. And no, I did not get to the mike often — when I had something I would have spoken on, someone usually said what I was thinking much better than what I would put together.

If you would like to know all of the details of the decisions that were made, I refer you to the RCA web page. Much of our work revolved around restructuring the denomination and collapsing the two layers of government the currently exist between the Consistory and the General synod into one layer of Middle Assembly. These changes will take effect at the end of 2026, and there will be opportunities to discuss how that will affect us as the work continues to make this happen. But what I want to share with you is my general feelings about the future of our denomination.

And despite some anxiety going in, my feeling is one of hope. There will be challenges, of course, but this year's gathering encouraged me that we will be able to do ministry together.

There was laughter. There were difficult but respectful discussions on current events – refugees, immigration, war. A conversation on mental illness encouraged many delegates to go to the microphone and share their own struggles and the struggles of their families in what was a safe and sacred space that would have been difficult to imagine in the contentious and divided years of the past. It was not all agreement, but none of the measures passed on a 51%/49% vote.

One story demonstrates the place where we are. James Hart Brumm, a professor at New Brunswick Seminary, was nominated to be a General Synod Professor. General Synod Professors are a unique fourth office to the RCA and are called to aid the denomination in their work. After the recommendation, Greg Brewer, came to the microphone. It was well known in the room that these two disagree on just about everything, and several times during these meetings had spoken passionately on opposite sides of several debates. So there was a slight fear as Greg was called on.

After acknowledging their usual lack of agreement on ANYTHING, he said, ""I think that our strength as a denomination is that we can disagree and disagree with grace. I know I'm not right about everything, and I need someone like James who disagrees with almost everything I think. I think James thinks he needs someone like me, too. I'm reminded in James that our unity is not uniformity, but our common love and unity in Jesus Christ."

So this is what gives me hope. That the years of contentious disagreement are past, and we have moved into an era of grace-filled unity. Not uniformity by any means, there were times when I disagreed strongly with what was being said by speakers, and by people with whom I shared a table. But it was good to be in a place and at a time where we could disagree agreeably and still be siblings in Christ at the end of it.

The RCA is approaching its 450<sup>th</sup> birthday. We are smaller than before – in parts of the country this commitment to unity in the face of disagreement has led to churches choosing to leave the denomination. But we are also opening up and expanding in ways we never imagined – the meetings were all simultaneously translated into Spanish and Portuguese so that leaders from churches in the global south could participate fully. We are truly learning the lessons of our crest – "In unity there is strength."


