Member: 1) A body part or organ, such as a limb. 2) One of the individuals composing a group. 3) A person baptized or enrolled in a church. (*Merriam-Webster*)

For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. ¹³ For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves^[a] or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit. – *1 Corinthians 12:12-13*

Words are funny things. They can have multiple meanings, but usually all of those meanings tie together in a common understanding. So if you know one meaning, and you hear it used in a different way, you can usually figure out what someone is trying to say. (There is actually a type of word called a contronym that has two meanings that are opposite each other, but they are rare and not in this post)

For this month’s “church word”, we will consider “**member**”. This is a word that we use often, in many contexts. But in Paul’s letter to the Corinthians, he lays out a beautiful picture of what it means to be a member of the body of Christ.

He is writing to an early church that is still getting used to the idea of moving from a bunch of people who have heard about Jesus and believe in him, to a group of people who will serve God together in the name of Christ. They are all coming with different stories and from different lives. They are people who might not ever have considered sitting next to each other. They might have spent their entire lives not speaking to each other. Except now... Jesus. Jesus has brought them together, Jesus has spoken to them all. And it is up to them to figure out how to work together.

And so Paul reminds them of something that they are intimately familiar with – their own bodies. They each have hands, feet, eyes, ears, and all of the other members that make up the body that gets them around each day. And each of those body parts – those members – do something different. And yet they all work together to get up in the morning, do their daily work, see, walk, speak, eat – everything that needs to be done to keep the body healthy. They might have had the experience of having a body part that didn’t work right, and how much harder that made getting their needed work done. And how even the tiny parts of the body can be the most important, depending on the task at hand.

And so, Paul says, is the body of Christ. We all have a job to do, and those jobs are all different. And we work better when we acknowledge and appreciate the function that each of the members brings to the table. We work together with all our sisters and brothers in Christ to serve God and our neighbors in Jesus’ name.

We also serve the body of Christ through our membership in individual denominations and local churches. Each of these serves as a body in which God's people can serve and also as a member of the larger body of Christ.

In the Reformed Church in America, membership in congregations includes "confessing" members, "baptized" members.

When an infant is baptized, they are received as a member of the church of Christ. They have a calling and a purpose and a ministry. That job for a while might be to learn at the feet of others the lessons of faith. But they are also welcomed to the Lord's Table and invited to participate in worship as they are able. It is important to remember and recognize their place in the body.

When a baptized member grows, they may reach a point at which they are ready to take on the baptismal vows made for them when younger. This is an opportunity to profess their faith and take their place as a full, functioning member of the community. The Elders will meet with them and invite them to commit to the work of the church – especially the hearing of the Word and the use of the Lord's Supper. This profession is the sign that they take seriously the work of the church and they commit to joining alongside others in that work.

This month, we will be celebrating those who have been members of the Fonda Reformed Church for many years. Their service to Christ and to his church here in Fonda have been part of the history that has allowed us to continue to do God's work. We honor them, and all who have put in the work to answer God's call as members of the church.

In May, we will be starting a new members class for those who are interested in taking the step of making a Profession of Faith here at Fonda Reformed Church. I invite you to prayerfully consider if this is a time for you to do this. Were you baptized years ago and never made a profession? Now may be the time. Have you been attending Fonda for years and never thought to join? This may be the moment. Are you a member who attended and had life or circumstances or Covid cause you to drift away? Come and recommit. If you are interested, or have any questions, please speak to myself or any of the Elders and we will keep you informed when we are starting up.

Because we are members of his body. (Ephesians 25:30) we find our individual purpose so that we can do the work together.





Camp Fowler

Camp Fowler is a non-profit children's camp grounded in openness, hospitality, and compassionate Christianity. They function first and foremost as a summer camp, aiming to provide

space for children to be themselves, learn from those who are different from them, and intimately experience wonder and love. Campers, Volunteers, and Staff are welcome regardless of race, gender, sexual orientation, or religious affiliation.

Fowler is a partner ministry of the Regional Synod of Albany, who supports their work. For 70 years, children of the church have had a great summer at Fowler.

Fowler offers overnight camp sessions for campers coming out of 3rd-12th grade. Campers who choose a Residential Camp week will stay in cabins on our 245 acre campus on the shores of Sacandaga Lake. Those who wish to explore the far corners of the Adirondacks can participate in one of our Wilderness trips led by our trained Guides. Whatever you choose, Camp Fowler just might be *the highlight of your summer*.
